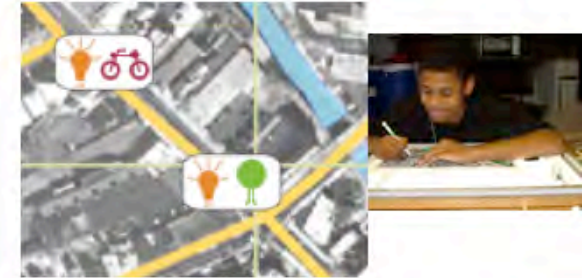

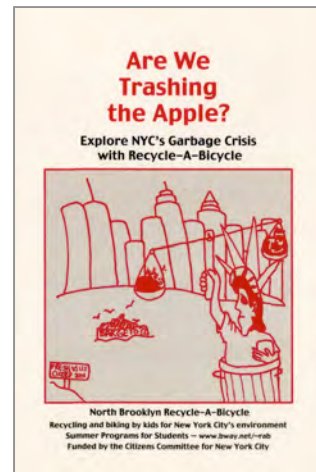




We have worked with more than a dozen NYC classes and educator groups as well as youth and community groups, such as Recycle A Bicycle, who have created their own inspiring Green Maps.



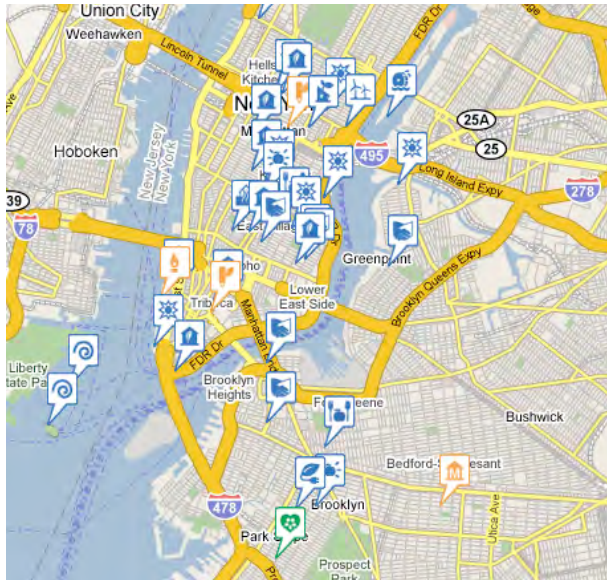

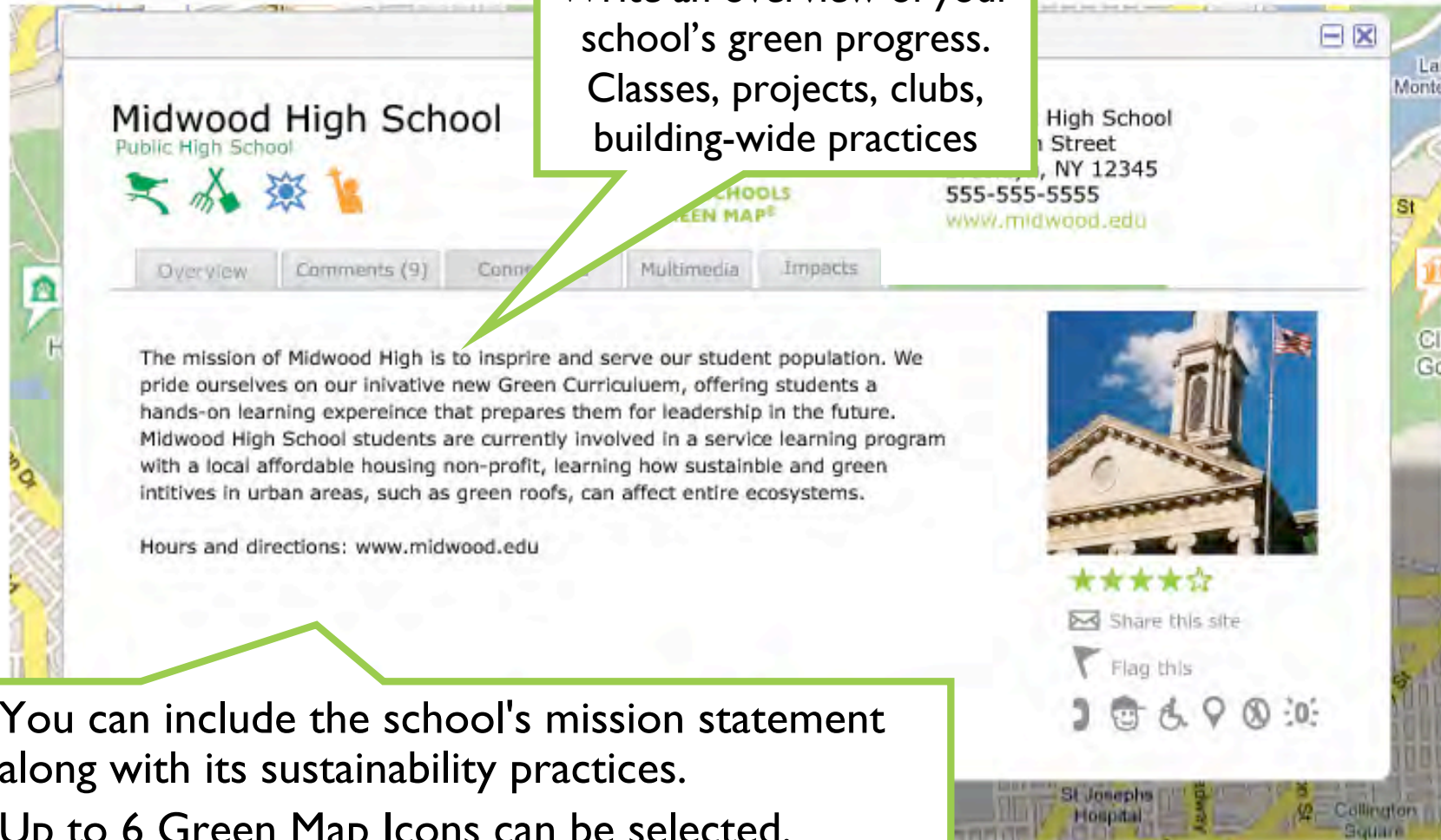
